

SCHOOL RULES

The school has a discipline code which outlines roles, responsibilities and rights of students, staff and parents. The following are general statements.

In order to play safely:

- If you arrive before 8.30pm sit on the silver seats near Administration car park.
- Stay in the playground where you can be seen by a teacher.
- Walk on walkways.
- Walk your bike across the playground.
- Ask a teacher for permission if you have to leave the school grounds.
- Use the school pedestrian crossing.
- Toy weapons are not allowed.
- Leave valuable or dangerous toys at home.
- Don't throw dangerous objects.
- Don't climb or damage trees or buildings.
- Remember '*Stranger Danger*' - Safety House Rules.
- Stay within the set boundaries.
- If a mobile phone is brought to school it is to be kept at the office or with the class teacher until the end of the school day.

You will be healthier if you:

- Do not play in toilets.
- Wash your hands after using the toilet.
- Put all rubbish in bins.
- Wear your school hat.

If we are considerate of others, school will be a pleasant place, so:

- Be a good sport
- Try to work out problems without arguing
- Listen carefully to your teachers and other school helpers
- Respect the beliefs and values of others

All people – teachers, students and visitors have the right to:

- Be respected in a polite way
- Be in a safe environment
- Expect their property to be safe
- Expect assistance if needed
