

SPORT: KINDERGARTEN – YEAR 2

Kindergarten to Year 2 students participate in a range of skill development sport activities each Friday. These include cricket, basketball, netball, soccer and T-ball skills, gymnastics, dance, fitness and games. At the end of the year intensive swimming has been included in the learning program for Years 1 and 2. Our K–2 students participate in the School Athletics Carnival and Year 2 students attend the Swimming Carnival.

SPORT: YEARS 3- 6

Sports activities are given on a Friday afternoon except in Term 1 and Term 4 of each year, when they are in the morning. Students are divided into senior and junior groups.

Summer activities are softball, cricket, dance, gymnastics, newcombe ball and T-ball.

Our students also participate in the Newcastle Primary School Sports Association Competition in Netball and Soccer and in State Knockouts in a range of sports.

Winter activities include different football skills, netball, basketball, soccer, touch and newcombe ball. Students are allocated to Houses for Athletics and Swimming Carnivals.
